

Cell Phone Policy

- Mobile devices should be 'off and away' during all class times in learning communities. In school, this means that
 the cell phone should be turned off and placed in a student's locked locker. For academic purposes, the teacher
 may require the students to use their mobile devices. This use of a mobile device and the time frame will be
 clearly communicated by the teacher and time will be given to return the device to their lockers before the next
 class.
- 2. If any mobile device/earbuds/phones are seen or heard in class, in the hallways or during lunch eating time during non-designated times, the student will be asked to take their mobile device to the office.
- 3. Devices delivered to the office will be returned at the end of the students' school day in the first and second instances. Should there be a third occurrence, a call will be made home requiring a parent/guardian to collect the child's device.
- 4. Students are still able to use their devices prior to school, during lunch recess, and after school.
- 5. Any students who require an exception to this policy based on previously implemented strategies at the school level will require permission from Mr. Coumont. Parents will need to schedule a meeting with Mr. Coumont to create a plan moving forward.
