Measures are based on the surveys . The categories are: Student Learning Engagement; Citizenship; Education Quality; Welcoming, Caring, Safe, Respectful Learning Environment, Access to Supports and Services; and Parental Involvement.

Faith Survey Results: 96% of students understand how helping others is what God teaches us to do. 100% of staff believe that St Lorenz ruiz encourages students and staff to understand the church's mission in helping the community and their personal responsibility to actively participate in our community through social justice.88% of parents believe that SLR creates opportunities for students to encounter and make connections with our faith through various experiences such as scripture reading, liturgies. sacraments and celebrations.94% of students understand what it means to love and help their neighbor as a Catholic member of our community.
- f. Community Events: The goal is to have 5 community events this school year run through the School Council.
- g. Required Alberta Education Assurance Measures - Overall Summary provided. The Grade 6 and 9 PATs scores were compared to the Provincial Average.

Board of Trustees Report :

Trustee's Report – November 2024 – Anne Marie Watson

At the October Board meeting, Trustees revisited th 3% increase in their remuneration which took effect on September 1, 2024, deciding to roll back the increase as of

November 1, 2024. The decision was made in solidarity with staff who haven't seen a wage increase, and in acknowledgement of the Division's difficult fiscal situation.

Two stakeholder engagement sessions were held in November (one online, the other in-person). Information on the provincial Education budget and the local RDCRS budget was presented, followed by small group discussion related to setting budget priorities. The themes from the groups I was part of were mental health supports, both within the Division and in the community (lack of supports), the desire for more communication from the Board, and a desire to prioritize spending on the classroom "basics" over spending that is the responsibility of other jurisdictions (e.g. mental health funding, social work funding).

Another round of engagement sessions will occur in the Spring; dates to be determined.

Update on the court cases brought against the Board by former Trustee Monique LaGrange. The 2 cases were heard in May and June, 2024. The judge has released her decision on the first case, which was about the Board's sanctioning Mrs. LaGrange; the actions of the Board were upheld by the Judge. We await a decision on the second case, but there is no timeline.

The next Board meeting is on Tue., Nov. 26, at 5:30pm. Everyone is welcome to attend. Some of the agenda items include the 2023/2024 Audited Financial Statements, the 2023/2024 Division Annual Education Results Report, and discussion on the 2025/2026 school calendars. Regarding that last item, note that the diploma exam schedule, which is set by Alberta Education, has students writing diploma exams almost 2 weeks earlier in the semester than normal, which will result in some significant anomalies in the calendar. Along with other school divisions in the province, RDCRS is advocating to Alberta Education to revert to the normal exam writing schedule in order to allow sufficient time to cover the curriculum.
